Job Summary:

Perform the day-to-day laboratory operations including testing of products per customer prints and relevant test standards (ASTM/ASME), report generating, gage and equipment monitoring and A2LA compliance. Also responsible for roaming floor inspections of all production areas to assist operators and supervisors with detection and monitoring to help mitigate defect creation and/or escapes.

Essential Duties and Requirements:

- Daily product testing: Operate all test equipment/gages including calipers, micrometers, height gages, optical comparator, proof load machine and hardness testing machine plus others. Proof load and hardness testing are the primary and only regular tests scheduled during the week. Other testing as needed.
- □ Generate and file required reports for testing, A2LA Lab requirements and PPAP support, including annual proficiency testing per ISO/IEC 17025.
- □ Gage and Equipment calibration management (GAGETrak Software used) for in-house gage calibration and the equipment requiring 3rd party certification.
- □ Production floor in process inspections at the machines using hand gages and calipers.
- **□** Read and interpret customer or company drawings and requirements.
- □ Assist Quality Manager (QM) with customer complaint investigations.
- Monitor and translate SPC data
- Coordinate with multiple team members including shipping for any customer concerns.
- □ Fill in during any QM absence for customer issues that may occur at the time, which includes being the main point of contact for the customer and organizing any required team responses.
- □ Any other duties/tasks as assigned by QM or Upper Management based on company needs.

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Skills, Requirements, and Qualifications:

- □ College degree (Engineering or Mechanical based preferred) and 2+ years of relevant fastener and/or metal/steel industry experience with quality inspections or testing.
- Or: 4+ years of relevant fastener and/or metal/steel industry experience with quality, inspections, or testing.
- □ Proficient with hand gages such as thread, plug, calipers, and mics, etc.
- Familiar with hardness and proof load testing
- □ ISO & IATF audit experience
- □ Internal auditing experience/qualified

- □ An understanding of print dimensions and how to measure specific features
- □ PPAP, APQP, FEMAs, and Control Plans
